BRAZIL'S AGRI-FOOD TRADE PROFILE

Brazil is one of the largest agri-food exporter countries in the world. Over the last 20 years, Brazil has become a major player in global agricultural markets with its corn, soybeans, cotton, coffee, sugar and beef exports, accounting for almost 5% of global agri-food exports. The aim of the paper is to investigate the agri-food trade profile of Brazil by analysing descriptive statistics on Brazilian agri-food trade exports and imports. Results show the major trade partners and products traded together with dynamics – the analysis concentrates on the period of 1990-2017, based on WITS data.
